

### Membership premiums

**Desktop mini-posters:** A tiny archival quality poster (4"x6") in a molded clear-plastic frame that stands on a flat surface.

**"Sisterhood Is Blooming"** (20"x26") is a hand-silkscreened poster created by the Women's Graphics Collective in 1970. We have a limited quantity in mint condition which were hand-silkscreened in the early 80s. This offer lasts until all the posters are gone. (There's no code number.)
